Considered one of the "Big Three" museums for Ancient Egyptian Art, the Metropolitan Museum of Art has one of the largest collections in the world. Included among the 30,000 Kemetic items, the MET boasts one of the best examples of cippi stelae (used to create "holy water" prior to the Christian era) and the entire Temple of Dendur. The Temple of Dendur was moved to the MET, block by block, from the Nubian border during the creation of the Aswan High Dam.

We will accomplish 2 objectives on this tour:

- 1) Develop an intimate portrayal of the Ancient Egypt's major personalities**
- 2) Describe the 5 major periods of Ancient Egyptian History and Art**
- 3) Uncover the keys to Ancient Egyptian spirituality and philosophy**



Jabari Osaze has studied Ancient Egypt for over 20 years, focusing primarily on the areas of philosophy, esoteric symbols and sacred science. Brother Osaze has led study groups in Egypt since 2002 and tours of the world-renowned Egyptian collections of New York's Brooklyn Museum and Metropolitan Museum of Art.

While completing his Bachelor of Science degree at Cornell University, Brother Osaze's studies led him to the monumental works of Ra Un Nefer Amen and R.A. Schwaller de Lubicz. This led him towards the practice of the Ancient Egyptian (Kemetic) ideal. In 1998, he was initiated into a Kemetic order, the Shrine of Ptah, by Chief Priest Heru Ankh Ra Semahj Se Ptah and was recently ordained as a Kemetic Priest. Jabari is a doctoral candidate at the University of Metaphysical Sciences and the Co-Producer and Co-Host of the TV Show, *Kemetic Legacy Today*. He is also the Co-founder of the Center for the Restoration of Ma'at.
